## **Club Formation**

### **Overview:**

Clubs or organizations selected for formation will be recognized by the MBASA for a probation period of two semesters. During this probation period, the club will receive \$150.00 per semester from the MBASA. After the probationary period has ended, the MBASA will review the performance of the club. Ideally, clubs will be self-sufficient at this time. If not, the review will assess whether the club is eligible for additional funding. Eligibility will be determined on a case-by-case basis. General criteria will include, but not be limited to, tangible benefits to the Fox graduate community, number of members, number of events, and future ability to become self-sufficient.

### **Procedure:**

Answer the following questionnaire. Be prepared to review answers with the Club Formation Review Board, comprised of the President, Vice President of Strategy and Operations, Vice President of Finance, and the Vice President of Marketing. Clubs or organizations that receive a majority of votes from the gathered MBASA members will be designated as having probation status. In the event of a tie vote, the President will have the final decision on the club or organization's status.

### **Questionnaire:**

What is the Mission Statement for your club or organization?

What are the goals of your club and organization, and how will these goals further the mission of the Fox MBASA?

What is your five-year plan for your club or organization?

How will the initial funding for the club given by the MBASA help further your club or organization's goals?

How will you continue to fund the club or organization in the future?

Give a tentative calendar of meetings and events for the next semester.

Give a recruitment goal for your club or organization and your plan to achieve it.

Give a semester budget.
